ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. Eligibility criteria for admission to the M.Phil. Programme:

- 1.1 Candidates for admission to the M.Phil. Programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- 1.2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

2. Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D. programme:

- 2.1 Master's degree holders satisfying the criteria stipulated in the clause 1 above.
- 2.2 Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and successfully completed the M.Phil. Degree shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph. D. Degree in the same University in an integrated programme. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories of candidates, as per prevalent rules of UGC and University.
- 2.3 A person whose M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph.D. programme of the same University.
- 2.4 Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. Programme.



3. Eligibility criteria for admission to M.A. in Education/ M.A. in Sanskrit/ Master of Journalism & Mass Communication (MJMC):

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Divyang candidates.

4. Eligibility criteria for admission to M.A. in Gandhian and Peace Studies:

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Divyang candidates.

OR

Bachelor's degree obtaining 45% marks in the subject of Gandhian and Peace Studies or 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

B.A. (Hons) in the subject of Gandhian and Peace Studies or Master's Degree in any other subjects.

OR

BA pass obtaining at least 45% marks in Gandhian and Peace Studies, History, Political Science, Economics, Philosophy, Psychology, Public Administration, Geography, Sociology, Ancient Indian History – Culture Archaeology, Women Studies, Human Rights & Duties, Defence Studies, Social Work, Police Administration.

5. Eligibility criteria for admission to M.L.I.Sc.:

Bachelor's Degree in Library and Information Science from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Divyang candidates.

6. Eligibility criteria for admission to B.L.I.Sc.:

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognised University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Divyang candidates.
