- **3.** Candidates are required to report personally on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with required documents.
- **4.** All candidates are advised to check their eligibility for respective programmes as notified by MGCU admission prospectus 2020-21 (http://mgcub.ac.in/pdf/MGCUB-Prospectus-20-21.pdf) before appearing for counseling/admission.
- 5. Merely obtaining the cut-off percentile or bringing Demand Draft does not guarantee for admission.
- **6.** Wait-listed candidates shall only be considered for provisional admission if seats remain vacant in the given program of studies.
