# Admission of candidates seeking admission after a gap of three or more academic years of their taking certificate/ diploma/degree/postgraduate degree from this University or any other University/educational institution/Board, shall be subject to the clearance by the **Admission Review Committee** consisting of the Dean, Students' Welfare (DSW), the Dean of the School concerned, the Head of the Department concerned and the Proctor.

## Instructions for candidates

1. At the time of counseling / admission candidates must use face covers/masks within and outside University premises.
2. Formats of selected documents required are specified in the e-Prospectus for Academic Session 2020-21 which is available at <http://mgcub.ac.in/pdf/MGCUB-Prospectus-20-21.pdf>
3. Admission shall be strictly based on **merit** derived from the **composite score** taken together on the basis of 20% of percentage of marks of Class-10<sup>th</sup> , 30% of percentage of marks of Class-12<sup>th</sup>, 40% of percentage of marks of Graduation, 5% of Extra Co-Curricular Activities and 5% of Interaction/Skill Test/Group Discussion in accordance to the provisions made in the University Prospectus (page 13-15).
4. **Date of third counseling/admission** into the MCom programme is **12 December, 2020**. Admission would be done in **order of merit** for all the categories, subject to reservation rules and overall intake capacity of **33 seats in M.Com**.
5. **Admission fee** for the MCom programme is **Rs. 9,218/-** . Admission fee would be deposited on the day of admission after document verification through challan. Fee structure and other details are provided in the e-Prospectus for Academic Session 2020-21.
6. If at any stage it is found that the applicant has deliberately furnished wrong information in the online application form then the admission would be cancelled.
7. **Admission** into MCom programme **would be confirmed only after** document verification and submission of proof of fee deposit through challan.
8. **SC/ST/OBC category candidates** must bring the **required category certificates in proper format** for admission, otherwise they would be treated as General category candidates. **Non-creamy layer certificate issued within last 6 months is essential** for OBC category candidates.
