#### **CIRCULAR**

- 3. Shri Radha Mohan Singh, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) and former Union Minister of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare will be the esteemed Chief Guest for this significant programme.
- 4. The objective of this programme is to foster a deep understanding of the "Panch Pran" principles among the students and faculty members, and to discuss their significance in the context of their academic and personal lives. Accordingly, all students and faculty members are requested to actively participate in the programme and contribute to the noble vision set forth by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India and to make a positive impact on our society.
