

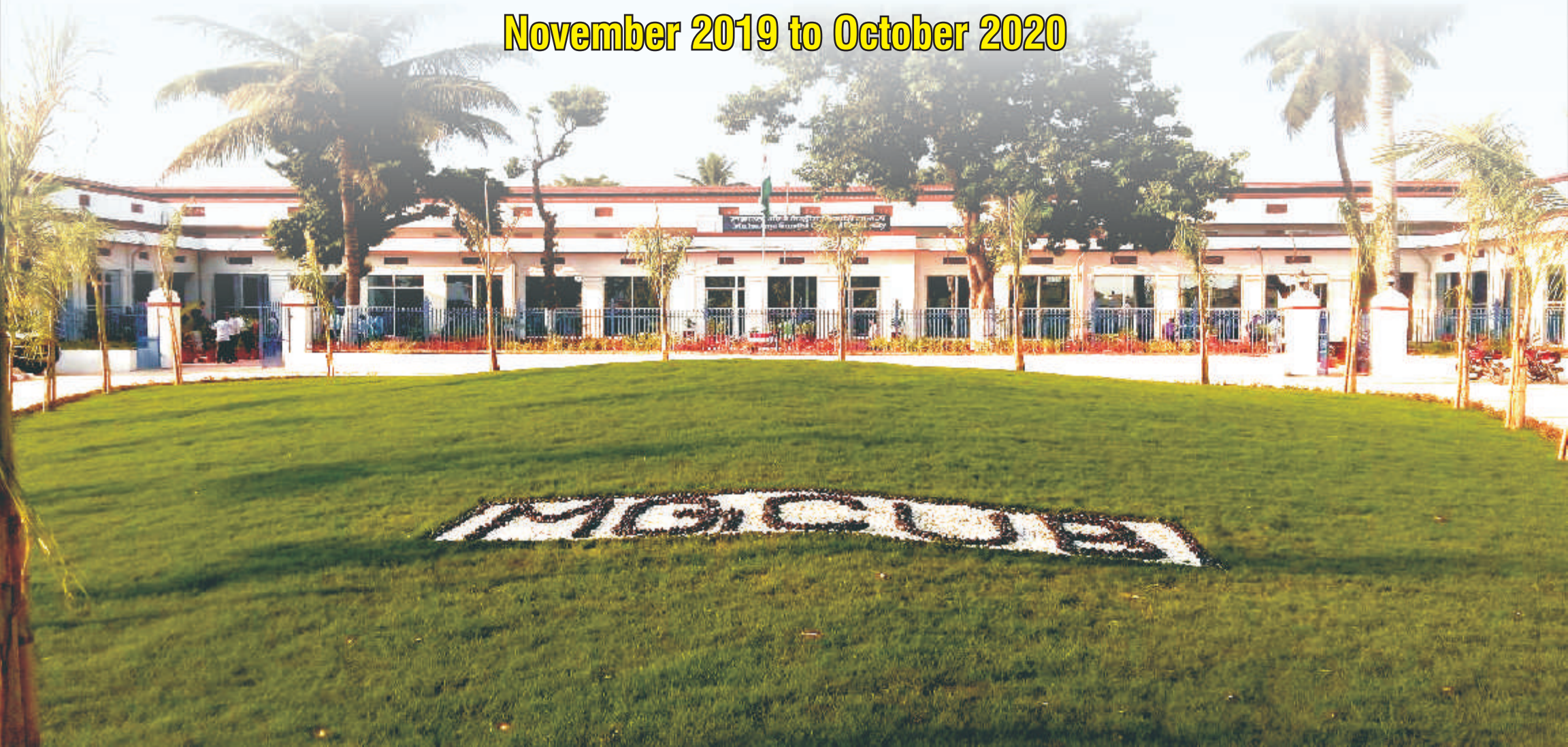

About East-Champaran District

East Champaran District is came into being on 2 November 1972. The headquarter of district is at Motihari. It is situated at 26°16' to 27°1' North latitude and 84°30' to 85°16' East longitudes. Nepal makes its northern boundary,

Sitamadhi and Sheohar eastern while Muzaffarpur South and with part of Gopalganj bounds it in western side. The name Champaran owes its origin to Champa-aranya or Champkatanys. Champa or Champaka means Magnolia and aranya means forest. Hence, Champaranya means Forest of Magnolia (CHAMPA) trees. The District comprises an area of 3968.0 km² with 1344 villages having population of 50,82,868 as per 2011 census. The Administrative set up of the District is decentralized into 6 sub-division, 27 blocks, 27 Circles, 3 Nagar Parishads (Motihari, Raxaul and Dhaka), 6 Nagar Panchayats and 405 Panchayats. The Buddhist Stupa, Kesaria, Ashokan Pillar, Lauriya, Areraj, Gandhi Memorial, Someshwar Shiv Mandir, Areraj, Orwell's birthplace, Raxaul-Gate way to Nepal.

Languages

Languages include Bhojpuri, a tongue in the Bihari language group with almost 4,00,00,000 speakers, written in both the Devanagari and Kaithi scripts as well as Urdu language also Urdu.

History

From the vedic time till today, the history of Champaran has been glorious and important. It is mentioned in the Purana that the devotee Dhruv, son of King Uttanapada, here had done terrible penance for attaining knowledge at the place called Tapovan. On the one hand, the land of Champaran is sacred due to the Goddess of Sita, on the other hand, the Satyagraha of Gandhiji in modern India is an invaluable page in the history of Indian independence. At the time of King Janak, this was part of the Tirahut kingdom. People believe that Jankigharh, also known as Chanchigarh, was the capital of King Janak's Veeveda state. Which later became part of the Vaishali empire in the 6th century BC. Lord Buddha had given his sermons here, in memory of which in the 3rd century BC, Priyadarshi Ashok made pillars and constructed stupas. After the decline of the Gupta Dynasty and the Pala Dynasty, the entire Champaran region, including Mithila, became subject to the Karnat dynasty. Local satraps were directly ruled by Muslims until and after this. Mahatma Gandhi came to Motihari in April 1917 on the call of Rajkumar Shukla, a rayat of freedom and freedom fighter of India during the freedom struggle, and successfully used the first successful experiment of Satyagraha in protest of the three acrimonious cultivation of the Nil crop. This was the beginning of the new phase in the fight for independence. Later, Bapu came here many times. The British had made Champaran an independent unit in 1866, but in 1971 it was divided into Eastern and Western Champaran.

About University

MAHATMA GANDHI CENTRAL UNIVERSITY (MGCU) came into existence by an Act of Parliament, Central Universities (Amendment) Act 2014 (No. 35 of 2014). The University became functional on 3rd February 2016. MGCU is situated in Motihari (Bankat), on National Highway 28.

MGCU is proving to be an excellent centre of Higher Studies in both Basic, Applied and Technical educational fields. There are as many as total 04 Undergraduate; 22 Postgraduate; 19 M.Phil. and 20 Ph.D. Programmes of Study running under total 07 Schools and 20 teaching Department under them. This is one of the salient characteristics of the University which has attracted the enthusiastic learners from different parts of the country to seek admission here. Needless to reiterate, the well-experienced and competent Faculty of the University is the central basis for the academic excellence being sustained herein.

The location of the University in Motihari, Bihar does take us to the glorious historic year of 1917 when Mahatma Gandhi started his well-known SATYAGRAHA, the first ever anti-colonial struggle against the British. It is rightly said that Motihari made Mahatma Gandhi the BAPU, the premier MASS LEADER who henceforward revolutionized the whole India through miraculous mantras of Truth and Non-Violence. 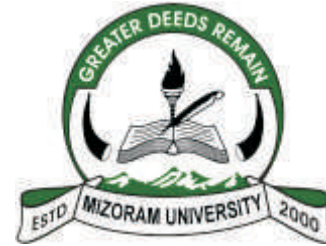


lecture Under the Theme- Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat-Pradeshannubhuti which fulfil the broader objective of EBSB.

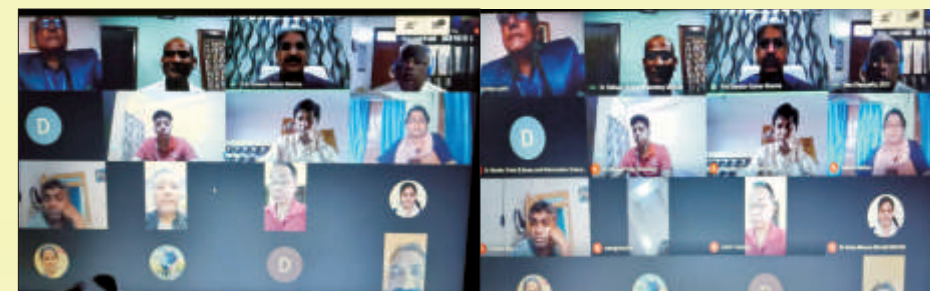

After the address of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of MGCU, Bihar and MZU, Mizoram, the committee has proceeds for the future planning of various activities under the guidance of the recent circular Reference No. MHRD Ref. No. F.No. 11018/02/2019-EBSB(Pt.I)-Part(I) dated 21st May 2020.

The following agenda were discussed in the meeting-

Agenda-1: Webinar: As per Guidelines of MHRD dated 21st May 2020, "Every HE institute must do at least one webinar every month with an institution in the paired state. The topic can be varied in nature-anything national importance/ importance of the two states/academic"

Resolution: After a thorough discussion among the members present in the meeting, it was decided that Webinar will be arranged by the two University as many as possible. The topic may be decided on the availability of the resource person and from the side of the members of the EBSB committee of both the university. Ideas and Suggestion from the members with resource persons is appreciated and can be shared with Nodal Officers of EBSB of both the University.

Agenda-2: EBSB Club/EBSB day: "EBSB Club in the institution must observe EBSB Day once in a month. Club members can teach each other songs / dance/ cuisine of their paired state. If there is a person from the paired state in the EBSB club, he/ she can teach the others. If not, selected members can be assigned the task of learning a song/ dish/ anything else from available internet resources and teach the others. EBSB Clubs from institutions in paired States/ UTs can also interact online, teaching each other similar things."

Resolution: The above points were discussed by the committee members. The EBSB Day celebrated by the Mizoram University on first Monday of every month and Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Motihari celebrates first Friday of every month (as decided earlier and communicated to the EBSB Cell of MHRD). The celebration of the EBSB day will be shared by both the institution. During the celebration of EBSB day through the participation and performance of various songs, dance of the paired state by the students will be encouraged.

Agenda-3: Language learning and Quiz: "100 sentences in 21 different languages will be shared by the EBSB and all students in HE institutions should be encouraged to learn the language of their paired states from these. Based on the language, every institution must conduct an online language quiz for students every month."

Resolution: The committee decided upon the discussion about the language learning and language quiz via competition among the students of the paired state based on the 100 sentences in 21 languages provided by EBSB as well as some other related topics. Competition regarding Knowledge of language learning may be conducted based on the story writing, easy writing, speech, translation of proverbs, motivational words, paragraph in paired state languages.

Agenda-4: WhatsApp / Skype Buddies Project: "Both the paired institute will form a common WhatsApp group so that any ideas that can be shared."

Resolution: Regarding the formation of WhatsApp / Skype Buddies, the committee discussed thoroughly. To fulfill the EBSB Campaign, initially 10 students each from 10 departments from both the university will form a WhatsApp groups and one faculty member from each university will be the mentor of the group. The mentor for each of the WhatsApp group will be nominated by the Nodal Officer of EBSB of their respective University. Initially the final year students will not be included WhatsApp groups. The committee also agreed to form more groups of this kind by including more students after from the newly admitted students whenever the admission of new academic Session 2020-21 by the respective universities. The Committee also agreed unanimously to form a WhatsApp group among the EBSB-Committee members of MGCU and MZU for sharing of information and related activities.

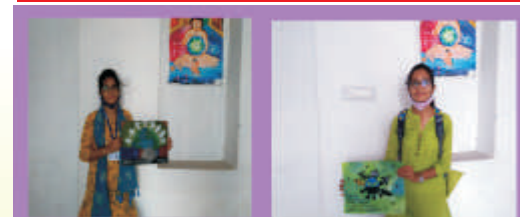

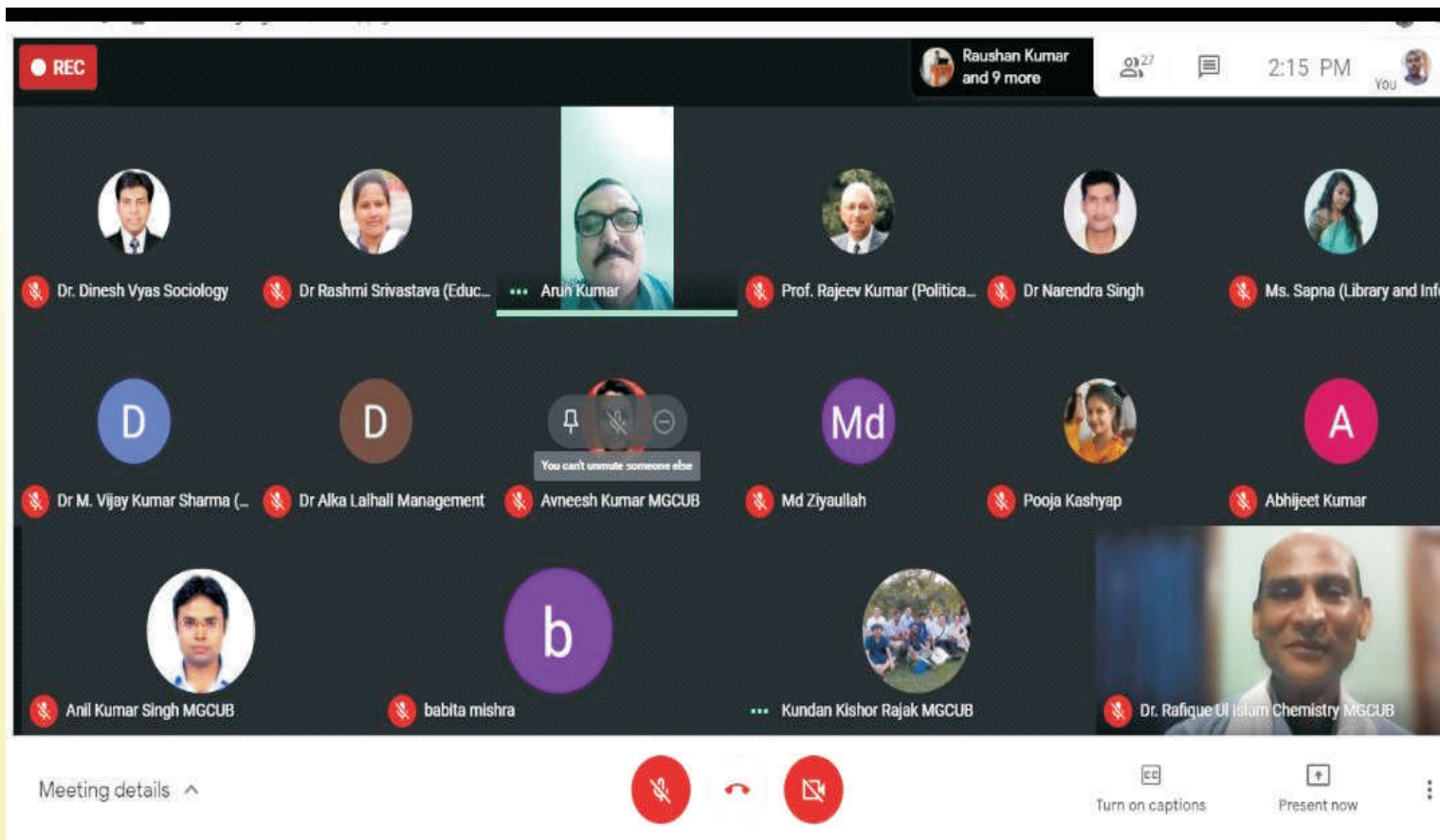
