General Regulations for M.Phil. Programme

1. Short Title

- 1.1. These Regulations may be called Mahatma Gandhi Central University M.Phil.

 Programme Regulations
- 1.2. In these Regulations 'ordinance' means the 'Ordinance No. 35' of the Mahatma Gandhi Central University

2. Eligibility Criteria and Admission Process

2.1. As per Ordinance No. 35 of the University

3. Duration of The Programme

3.1. As per Ordinance No. 35 of the University.

4. Credits and Evaluation Method for the Award of M.Phil. Degree

- 4.1. Students are expected to attend all lectures in order to be able to fully benefit from the course.
- 4.2. A minimum of 75% attendance is a must failing which a student may not be permitted to appear in examination.
- 4.3. The credit assigned to the M.Phil. course work shall be a minimum of 08 credits and a maximum of 16 credits. The overall minimum credit requirement, including credit for the course work, for the award of M.Phil. degree shall not be less than 24 credits.

4.4. The maximum marks for per course shall be 100 and bifurcation of the marks shall be as per given table-

| Evaluation criteria | Type of Evaluation | Marks |

| Mid Semester Examination | Mid Semester Exam shall be internal and conducted at the departmental level. | 20 Marks |
| Comprehensive Continuous Internal Assessment | 5 marks shall be for attendance and All the concerned teacher shall make it convenient to evaluate students basic research aptitude by taking term paper/assignment/seminar/presentation etc. This assessment shall be of 15 Marks. | 20 Marks (5+15) |
| End Semester Examination | At the end of the semester a final written exam shall be conducted of 60 Marks | 60 Marks |

5. Evaluation Criteria for Dissertation:

- 5.1. Upon satisfactory completion of Semester I, the M. Phil. scholar shall produce a Dissertation in the second semester. The dissertation shall be of 100 marks.
- 5.2. The allocation of research supervisor for the M.Phil. Dissertation shall be as per Ordinance No. 35.
- 5.3. The credit assigned to the M.Phil. dissertation shall be equal to first semester.
- 5.4. The basic evaluation scheme of the dissertation is given in Ordinance No. 35. The detailed evaluation scheme of the M.Phil. Dissertation as follows:-
 - 5.4.1. At the end of second semester a viva-voce shall be conducted for the evaluation of dissertation. The supervisor shall coordinate the viva-voce in the chairmanship of the head of the department.
 - 5.4.2. At the time of viva-voce, dissertation shall be evaluated by his/her Research Supervisor and one external examiner to be appointed by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor.
