CIRCULAR

- 1. Pursuant to (i) D.O.No.08/Secy (I&B)2020 dated 25th November 2020 received from Ministry of Information and Broadcasting; (ii) D.O.No.F.1-62/2019(Website) dated 25th November 2020 received from University Grants Commission; and (iii) meeting taken by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of the University on 25th November 2020 through Virtual Mode, it is hereby notified for information of all concerned that to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India, the Constitution Day (also known as *Samvidhan Divas*) shall be celebrated on 26th November 2020 (Thursday) at all the three Academic Campuses, Dr Ambedkar Administrative Building and Kasturba Gandhi Women's Hostel of the University.
- 2. All Deans and Heads of various Teaching Departments shall ensure that all faculty members under their respective School and Department participate in the Constitution Day Celebration at their respective Academic Campus. All Administrative Staff have also to be present in their respective offices.
- 3. As part of the celebration, this year the Hon'ble President of India will be leading the Nation at 11:00 AM on 26th November 2020 in reading the Preamble of the Constitution of India to mark the occasion of "Constitution Day". This event will be telecast live by DD News.
- 4. In view of the above, all Campus Directors, Provost and Women's Hostel Warden are requested to make following arrangements at their respective Campus and Hostel:
 - i. Ensure the reading of the Preamble to the Constitution (*The text of the preamble in Hindi and English is attached herewith*) at the appointed time i.e., 11:00 AM on the 26th November 2020 (Thursday) in the limited gathering while wearing the mask, and following the social distancing and government guidelines;
 - ii. Necessary arrangement for students, faculty and staff to join the reading of preamble through virtual platform may be made. Also, they may be informed of the live telecast on DD News of the reading of the preamble by the Hon'ble President of India;
 - iii. Still Photography and Videography of the entire said celebration; and

- iv. A brief report about the celebration of the event is to be submitted to the office of the undersigned latest by 4:00 PM on 26th November 2020, for preparation of final report and its onward submission.
- 5. The Dean, School of Computational Sciences, Information and Communication Technology alongwith his team shall ensure that the Preamble of the Constitution (both in Hindi and English) is uploaded and is visible prominently on the landing page of the University Website.
- 6. Further, the Public Relations Officer of the University shall ensure that the Photographs/ Short Videos of entire programme are uploaded/updated on all Social Media Platforms of the University using hashtag **#SamvidhanDiwas**, as well as tagging PIB at @PIB_India, DD News at @DDNewslive and AIR at @airnewsalerts and also at @MIB_India.
- 7. This is in supersession of the Circular dated 25th November 2020 issued earlier today by the office of the undersigned.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA, having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a ³[SOVEREIGN SOCIALIST SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political;

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity;

and to promote among them all

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the ⁴[unity and integrity of the Nation;

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty-sixth day of November, 1949, do HEREBY ADOPT, ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION.
