Eligibility Criteria: B.Sc (Honors) degree in Chemistry or Bachelor degree of three years duration with Chemistry as a subject till 3rd Year as one of the subject of study from a recognized Indian or Foreign University (Foreign recognition to per as per AIU list) with a minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer)/PWD candidates

During Open Counselling the admission shall be made on merit of CUET Score/composite score to be determined on the basis of score obtained in 10th, 12th, Graduation as per following details, as the case may be:

Admission process: The counselling-cum-admission will be done in the following order of preferences:

1. First, the Candidates who have valid CUET (PG) – 2023 score and **have also filled the Registration form** of Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Bihar.

2. Then the Candidates who have valid CUET (PG) – 2023 score but **have not filled the Registration form** of Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Bihar.

3. If any seats still remains vacant, the option will be given to the Candidates **who have not** given the CUET (PG) – 2023 exam in the open counselling and allotment will be done as per composite score.

<u>How to Apply</u>: All the eligible candidates having eligibility and aspiring for admission must fill the online application by clicking the link given below on or before 03/09/2023.

Fee of Registration: The candidates who are interested to appear in open counseling can pay

Registration fee on the date of open counseling through Bank Challan.

Category wise registration Fee is given under:

- Rupees five hundred (Rs. 500) for General/OBC/EWS
- Rupees Two Hundred (Rs.200) for SC/ST/PWD

Important Instruction

- 1. Candidates are advised to follow the COVID guidelines at the time of counselling.
- **2.** Admission shall be based on CUET (PG) 2023 score/Composite merit Score for non CUET Candidates.
- **3.** Candidates are advised to report on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with required documents.
- 4. Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.

- 5. In case of tie, senior candidate on the basis of Date of Birth shall be given preference. In case of any dispute, the decision of the University administration shall be final.
- **6.** The admission of candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
- 7. The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of **Challan** at the time of admission.
- 8. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
- 9. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
- **10.** In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
- 11. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (<u>www.mgcub.ac.in</u>). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

The candidates are required to be present in person and bring the following documents in **original** as well as a set of **attested photocopies** at the time of reporting for admission:

- 1. NTA score card of CUET (PG) 2023 (for CUET candidates only)
- 2. Marksheets and certificates of 10^{th} and 12^{th} .
- 3. Marksheet and Certificate of Graduation.
- 4. Five copies of recent passport size photographs.
- 5. Bank Account detail of student i.e. Account No., IFSC-Code, Name of account holder & address of Bank.
- 6. A Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
- 7. Transfer/Migration Certificate (in original) from the Head of the Institution/University last attended.
- 8. Affidavit for intervening period/gap of over three years, if applicable on 10/- stamp paper.
- 9. Valid SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS Certificate as per GOI rules, wherever applicable.
- 10. No Objection Certificate (NOC) from Employers, wherever applicable.
