**Notice for Open Counseling for the Admission in M.Sc. Chemistry against Vacant Seats  
Session 2024-25**

The **Spot Counselling** for admission against vacant seats in M.Sc. Chemistry programme is scheduled on **31<sup>st</sup> July, 2024** at **Department of Chemistry, MCGU, Motihari Bihar**. The candidates may appear in the spot counselling, and the criteria for admission would be based on a composite score, which will be determined as under:

S. No.	Components	Weightage of different components of the composite score (out of 100)
1.	Percentage of Marks in 10 <sup>th</sup>	20%
2.	Percentage of Marks in 10 + 2/ Intermediate	35%
3.	Percentage of Marks Graduation	45%

All the candidates who have met the eligibility criteria for the admission in M.Sc Chemistry at Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Motihari may appear for open counseling for filling up the vacant seats left.

**Eligibility Criteria:** B.Sc (Honors) degree in Chemistry or Bachelor degree of three years duration with Chemistry as a subject till 3<sup>rd</sup> Year as one of the subject of study from a recognized Indian or Foreign University (Foreign recognition to per as per AIU list) with a minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-creamy layer)/PWD candidates

All the eligible candidates are advised to appear for counseling for admission to the above programme on the scheduled **DATE AND TIME in the Department of Chemistry, MCGU, Motihari, Bihar**.

1. Admission shall be based on the composite score as mentioned above.
2. Candidates are advised to report to the venue on the scheduled date and time along with required documents.
3. All candidates are advised to check their eligibility available at <https://mgcub.ac.in/pdf/2024041519030432d9e3d5af.pdf>.
4. Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.
5. In case of tie, senior candidate on the basis of Date of Birth shall be given preference. In case of any dispute, the decision of the University administration shall be final.
6. The admission of candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
7. The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of **Challan** at the time of admission.
8. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
9. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
10. In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
11. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website ([www.mgcub.ac.in](http://www.mgcub.ac.in)). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.
