**Notice for Open Counselling-cum-Admission Process M.A./M.Sc. in
Mathematics against Vacant Seats**

Open Counselling for admission against vacant seats in **M.A./M.Sc. (Mathematics)** programme is scheduled to be held **on 31st July 2024 for CUET(PG)-2024 Score Card holders and without CUET(PG)-2024 Score Card holders** at the Department of Mathematics, MGCU, Motihari Bihar.

1. The Candidates who have valid CUET (PG) – 2024 score in SCQP19 and have also filled the Registration form and paid the registration fee of Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Bihar.
2. The Candidates who have valid CUET (PG) – 2024 score in SCQP19 but have not filled the Registration form* of Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Bihar.
3. **However, the candidates who appeared in CUET(PG)-2024 shall be given priority in the admission process.**
4. The candidates interested in taking admission have to pay registration fees (Rs. 500/- for UR/OBC/EWS and Rs. 200/- for SC/ST/PWD) through challan along with the admission fee (Rs. 9218/-).

2. Admission shall be based on CUET (PG)-2024 score in SCQP19.
3. Candidates are advised to report on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with the required documents.
4. Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.
5. **In case of a tie, the senior candidate, based on Date of Birth, shall be given preference.** In case of any dispute, the University administration's decision shall be final.
6. The admission of a candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
7. The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of Challan at the time of admission.
8. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
9. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
10. In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
11. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.
