[Corrigendum to Notice dated 8-8-2025 regarding IInd Open Counseling for Admission to M.Sc. Botany against Vacant Seats (Session 2025-26)]

1. In view of the office order MGCUB/CoE/2025/CUET-PG/1808 dated 15-8-2025 regarding extension of the last date for admission to the PG programs through open counseling, an Open Counseling for admission against vacant seats in M.Sc. Botany program is scheduled on 28th August, 2025 at the Department of Botany, MGCU, Motihari, Bihar. The details of vacant seats are as follows:

** Selected candidates need to pay admission fees online at the time of allotment, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next candidate as per the merit.

To participate in the open counseling, candidates have to register by logging through the link mgcubadm.samarth.edu.in on or before **25th August 2025** for the open counseling by paying the registration fee (Rs. 500/- for Gen/OBC/EWS and Rs. 200/- for SC/ST/PWD).

Important: Those who have earlier applied on the Samarth portal against the Notice dated 8-8-2025 need not apply again.

Criteria for Open Counseling

- i. Open counseling will be initiated by the department against the vacant seats for the following category of candidates:
 - CUET score card holders (first preference)
 - Without CUET score card holders (but fulfilling eligibility criteria of MGCUB)
- ii. During open counseling, admission shall be made on the merit of CUET score. Once such candidates are exhausted, merit will be prepared based on the composite score, to be determined on the basis of score obtained in 10th, 12th, and Graduation as per following details:

1.	Percentage of marks in 10 th	20%

4. The admission of a candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
5. The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of Challan at the time of admission.
6. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
7. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
8. In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
9. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.
