Paper Submission Guidelines:

Original/ Unpublished research papers are invited for presentation/ publication in the conference. Please refer to the following guidelines for paper submission:

- The paper should be typed in MS Word & written in English.
- The first page continues title of the paper, author’s name, designation, affiliation and email id & contact number.
- The second page should include an abstract of not more than 150 words with five keywords.
- The paper should be written in TIMES NEW ROMAN with 12 font style.
- Referencing should be in APA style (7 Edition).
- Manuscript should not exceed more than 7000 words in all with 1.5 spacing throughout.
- Tables & figures must be numbered in sequence as they appear in the text and should include clear titles, notes or source details wherever needed. The main body of the manuscript should follow this structure:
 1. Introduction
 2. Literature Review & Research Gap
 3. Objective
 4. Data & Study Period
 5. Hypothesis if any
 6. Research Methodology
 7. Result & Analysis
 8. Conclusion & Recommendation (including Policy Implications)

The extended abstract must include the following points:

1. Purpose
 2. Design/ Methodology/ approach
 3. Findings
 4. Research limitations/ Implications
 5. Originality/ Value
- Only complete papers/ extended abstract will be considered. The papers must be submitted by the deadline via the google form link or QR Code.

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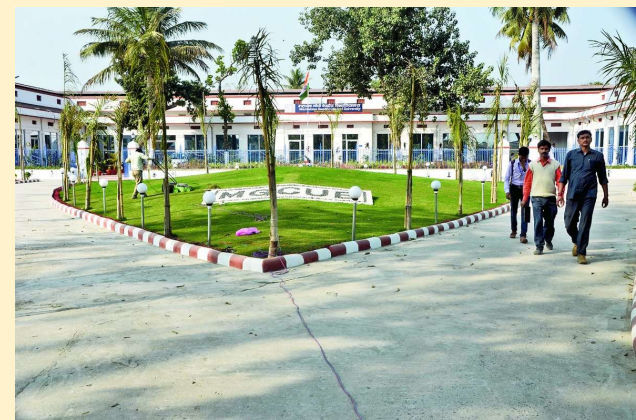
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
