Candidates who are interested in seeking **admission through Open Counselling to the M.A. IN SANSKRIT**. programme of this University for the Academic Session 2026–2027 are hereby informed to register themselves on the MGCUB/Samarth Portal (<https://mgcubadm.samarth.edu.in/>) by paying the prescribed non-refundable registration fee of **₹500/- for General/OBC/EWS candidates and ₹200/- for SC/ST/PwD candidates** from **21st July, 2026 to 31st July, 2026**. The registered candidates are advised to appear for Counselling-cum-Admission to the M.A. IN SANSKRIT. programme on 05th August, 2026 (Wednesday) and report to the Department of Sanskrit, Gandhi Bhawan Campus, Bankat, Mahatma Gandhi Central University, Motihari, Bihar, on 10:00 A.M.

Eligibility: B.A. (Hons.) Sanskrit /B.A. (Pass) Sanskrit/ Acharya / Shastri or Graduation from any stream with dialectical efficiency and competence in Sanskrit Language and Literature from a recognised Indian or Foreign University (foreign recognition to be as per AIU list) with a minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade for unreserved category and 45% marks or equivalent grade for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/PWD /EWS candidates.

OPEN COUNSELING WILL BE INITIATED AGAINST THE VACANT SEAT FOR FOLLOWING CATEGORY OF CANDIDATES:

- Candidates CUET (PG)-2026 Score Card Holders
- Without CUET (PG)-2026 Score Card Holders but fulfilling eligibility criteria of MGCUB

During open counseling the admission shall be made on the basis of CUET (PG)-2026 score, once such candidates are exhausted merit will be prepared based on the composite score determined as follows:-

Components	Weightage of different components of the Composite Score (Out of 100)
Percentage of marks in 10th	20%
Percentage of marks in 10+2/Intermediate	35%
Percentage of marks in Graduation	45%
Total	100%
