To participate in the open counselling, candidates have to register on the link (<https://mgcubadm.samarth.edu.in/>) till **25th August, 2026** for the open counselling by paying the registration fee (Rs. 500/- for Gen/OBC/EWS and Rs. 200/- for SC/ST/PWD)

The admission against the vacant seats will be made as per the criteria given in **Annexure-I**.

1. The Candidates who have a valid CUET (PG) – 2026 score card;
2. The Candidates not having the CUET (PG) – 2026 score card but fulfilling the eligibility criteria of MGCUB.

Important Instruction

1. Candidates are advised to report on the scheduled date and time to the venue along with the required documents (List given below).
2. All candidates are advised to check their eligibility criteria for M.Sc. Physics programme as notified through:

3. Candidates who fail to report for admission along with all the original documents on the scheduled date and time shall forfeit their claim to be considered for admission.
4. In case of tie, senior candidate on the basis of Date of Birth shall be given preference. In case of any dispute, the decision of the University administration shall be final.
5. The admission of candidate who has passed his/her qualifying examination from a Foreign University will be subject to his/her qualification being found equivalent to the qualifications prescribed by the University.
6. The candidates shall be required to pay the fees in the form of **Challan** at the time of admission.
7. Admission shall be granted only on the payment of fees on the specified date.
8. Candidates who fail to make payment on the date of admission shall not be considered for admission and the seat will be given to the next candidate in the merit list.
9. In case of any dispute related to the provisional admission, the High Court of Patna shall have jurisdiction.
10. Any addendum/corrigendum/notices to this notification shall be published only on the University Website (www.mgcub.ac.in). Therefore, Candidates are advised to check the University website regularly for any updates.



LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION

The candidates are required to be present in person and bring the following documents in **original** as well as a set of **attested photocopies** at the time of reporting for admission:

1. CUET (PG) application form for CUET (PG) – 2026 appeared candidates.
2. NTA score card for CUET (PG) – 2026 appeared candidates.
3. Copy of filled registration form for admission through open counseling in MGCU.
4. Marksheets and certificates of 10th and 12th.
5. Marksheet and Certificate of Graduation.
6. Three copies of recent passport size photographs.
7. Self-attested copy of AADHAR card.
8. Bank Account detail of student i.e. Account No., IFSC-Code, Name of account holder & address of Bank.
9. A Character certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended.
10. Transfer/Migration Certificate (in original) from the Head of the Institution/University last attended.
11. Affidavit for intervening period/gap of over three years, if applicable on 10/- stamp paper.
12. Valid SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PwD/EWS Certificate as per GOI rules, wherever applicable.
13. No Objection Certificate (NOC) from Employers, wherever applicable.
14. Anti-ragging affidavit duly signed by the students & parents/guardians (in the format **Annexure-II and Annexure-III** given below) *to be filed if admission is granted*.
